APPLICATION PROCESS

Step One: *Shadow Day*

Your son is cordially invited to attend Northridge Prep for what we call a “Shadow Day.” This is an excellent opportunity for a prospective student to experience first-hand a typical day at Northridge. He will be assigned a student leader to accompany him throughout the day and will have the chance to meet and speak with various coaches and club moderators. We prefer to have students visit on Fridays but are open to any day that is convenient for you and your family. In order to schedule a Shadow Day, please call the Admissions Office at 847.375.0600.

Step Two: *Application for Admission*

This application must be submitted with all corresponding components in order for your son to be considered for admission. These components are listed in their entirety on the front page of this application.

Step Three: *Entrance Examination*

All students, regardless of grade level, are required to take the Northridge Prep entrance exam. This exam lasts approximately two hours and can be scheduled by calling the Admissions Office at 847.375.0600.

Step Four: *Application Review and Conference with the Headmaster*

Following your son’s Shadow Day and the submission of a completed application package, the Admissions Committee will meet to review his file. The final step will be for your son and *both* parents to come in for a brief interview with the Headmaster. This interview is mandatory and typically lasts 30 minutes.

Step Five: *Enrollment Contract*

If your son is granted admission to Northridge Prep, an enrollment contract will be mailed to your home. The contract must be completed and returned with a \$500 non-refundable deposit within 15 days to secure a place in next year’s class.
