## Guidelines for Students at PACE Events

- 1) **Students are encouraged to arrive within one hour of the announced starting time.**
  - a) Admittance after that hour will be at the discretion of the chaperones.
  - b) Students loitering in parking lot and /or cars may be denied admittance at the discretion of chaperones.
- 2) **Anyone leaving the premises will not be readmitted.**
- 3) **All students and guests must produce a student ID or driver's license to be admitted to any PACE function.**
- 4) **Use or possession of alcohol or controlled substances is illegal and prohibited.**
  - a) Random or targeted testing using a breathalyzer will be implemented at chaperones discretion.
  - b) Students showing signs of intoxication or substance abuse will not be admitted or will be removed from the event. Parents will be notified immediately and are expected to pick up their student. Police may be notified at the discretion of the chaperones.
  - c) Students refusing to take a breathalyzer test will be removed from the dance and their parents called to pick them up.
  - d) Inappropriate behavior will be reported to respective schools.
- 5) **Smoking will not be allowed.**
- 6) **Shoulder riding, moshing, grinding and suggestive dancing are not permitted.**
  - a) *Dancing partners are expected to dance facing each other.*
  - b) Dancing should be safe and appropriate.
  - c) Those who dance inappropriately will be warned to stop. If they persist they may be removed from the dance. In this event parents will be notified and may be asked to pick up their child.
  - d) Participation in future dances may be suspended for a time designated by the PACE board.
- 7) **Appropriate dress is required.**
  - a) Dress code will be based on normal standards of modesty. For example, low cut, backless dresses or bare midriffs are not considered appropriate.
  - b) Immodest attire will result in a request from the chaperones to change clothes, wear a wrap, or leave the dance.
- 8) **Guest policy (Non-NRP/Willows students):**
  - a) Students wishing to bring a guest to an event must procure a guest pass at the school prior to the dance.
  - b) The student procuring the guest pass is responsible for the guest and must be with him at all times.
  - c) Students are limited to two guests at one event.
  - d) Unacceptable behavior on the part of the host or guest could result in the loss of the host student's privilege to bring future guests.
- 9) **Inappropriate behavior at a PACE function may result in suspension of the student's social activity privileges.**
