- A proponent of school choice options, he graduated from Carmel High School in Mundelein, Il and has children attending The Heights and Oakcrest, "cousin" schools to NRP and TWA.
- Believes that the core of the American experience is the family, and without strong families, we cannot have a strong and vibrant nation.
- During his time in office, Senator Santorum was the author of the "Born Alive Infant Protection Act" and "Unborn Victims of Violence Act".
- Promoted the passage of the "Individuals with Disability Education Act" (IDEA), and coauthored the "Combating Autism Act".
- Senator Santorum worked in a bipartisan manner to create Kids Accounts. He also authored the Schools SAFE Act.
